# Monitoring of online searches in school

As part of our safeguarding measures, we obviously have a tightly controlled system provided by our Wifi company, CoConnect, to ensure that any search terms that may bring up unsuitable content are prohibited. We thought it was worth you knowing that if there are any searches being made using terms that might do so, Mrs Mullen and Mrs Bowen receive emails to alert us as to who is searching for what. Sometimes a simple spelling error can lead to blocked content messages. So far, we have not had to have any difficult conversations with children (or staff) about inappropriate search terms, but we wanted to make you aware that we have this facility and this is all part of what we do to protect your child at school when online.

Please make sure you have strict parental controls and restrictions on all devices your child may use at home.
