Learning Journey 1: Constance in Peril

The Hook-

Outcome: To write instructions on staying safe.

Learning Journey 2 : Non fiction texts about Toys

The Hook

Children will bring in their favourite toy from home and we will look at the similarities and differences between the toys.

Outcome: Factfile about toys.

What we will be teaching:

English:

Continuing to recap of Phase 2 and 3 phonics taught in Year R. Introducing new Phase 5 sounds and alternative GPCs and applying this to our writing. We are also practising editing and improving our work through the use of chimp and check.

Maths:

Revisiting simple division from last half term.

Exploring shapes and their properties and using mathematical language to describe the shapes.

Thinking about place value up to 100.

Addition and subtraction in different contexts.

History:

Toys through time and thinking about how they have changed.

Science:

Animals: Learning how animals survive.

Art:

Opportunities in provision to explore different art skills with a particular focus on colour. Learning how to mix different colours and how to make colours lighter or darker.

RE:

Incarnation: Why does Christmas Matter to Christians?

Computing:

Technology in the classroom - creating digital artwork.

PE:

Indoor - Dance
